COASTAL LANDSCAPES

- Shots from high vantage points
- Rough seas, crashing waves
- Coastal marshes, tidal flats
- Beaches, dunes
- Intertidal zone
- Fog shrouded coastal forests
- Coastal cliffs



FLORA AND FAUNA

- Close ups/eye catching shots of COSEWIC listed coastal plain flora species (eg. Thread-leaved Sundew, Pink Coreopsis, Sweet Pepperbush) and other species at risk (eg. Eastern White Cedar, Ram's Head Lady Slipper, Boreal Felt Lichen)
- Floodplain forest rare plants
- Waterfowl: close ups, pair shots or congregations (eg. Harlequin Ducks, Eiders, Goldeneyes)
- Shorebirds: close ups, or flock shots (eg. all the Plovers [particularly Piping], Sandpipers, Yellowlegs, Roseate Terns)

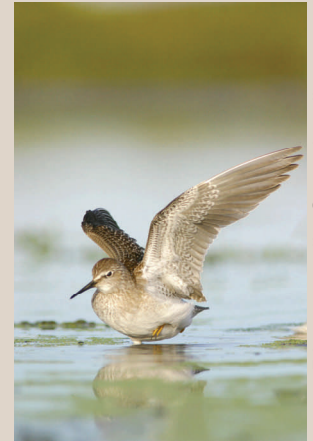

- Old growth forests and large trees
