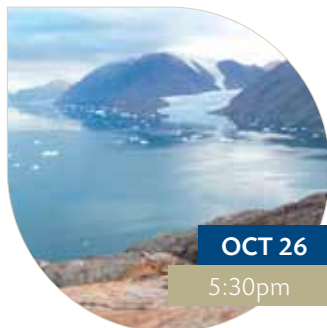
### FOREVER WILD
